The United Nations Security Council,

Acknowledging the contributions of the *National League for Democracy (NLD)* to the democratization process of Myanmar over the course of twelve years and the social and political influences this democrat transition has posed,

Commending the continued efforts of the Special Envoy of the Secretary-General on Myanmar, the Permanent Representative of Myanmar to the United Nations, and previous assistance from successive Special Rapporteurs in addressing the circumstances of this situation,

Deeply alarmed by the situation of stateless Rohingya refugees fleeing into neighboring States,

Determined to restore peace and security in Myanmar and its constituencies,

Expressing its concern for the unlawful usurpation of power by the Tatmadaw and the political detention of the democratically elected leaders of the NLD party,

Guided by its mandate to maintain international peace and security in accordance with the *Charter of the United Nations*,

Having considered A/HRC/46/L.21/Rev.1 adopted by the *United Nations Human Rights Council* and A/RES/61/232 (2006) of the *United Nations General Assembly* regarding the situation of Human Rights in Myanmar, and to this end *reiterating its dismay* towards large-scale human rights abuses by the State's military,

Recalling resolution S/RES/1296 (2000) on the Protection of Civilians in Armed Conflict,

Recognizing the coup d'etat in Myanmar as a threat to international peace and security and the need to put an immediate resolution to the issue,

Hereby resolves,

1. *Demands* humanitarian aid for the general public, especially for the minority groups of Myanmar;
 - a. *Request* humanitarian aid from third-party non-governmental organizations (NGOs) such as the *International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC)*, the *International Medical Corps*, the *Global Humanitarian Assistance*, and others who are willing to join the initiative;
 - b. *Designates* that all parties must recognize the neutral medical mission that would ensure the welfare of all minority groups of the country;
2. *Urges* the protection of refugees and minorities suffering from state-sponsored oppression;
 - a. *Affirms* that non-cooperation or insufficient cooperation can lead to more international intervention;
 - b. *Further invites* third-party NGOs to monitor direct humanitarian actions of different parties to ensure their success;
 - c. *Calls upon* consenting Myanmar's neighboring countries to ensure the protection of refugees and minorities upon the agreement between the *United Nations Peacekeepers* and the respective host country of deploying peacekeeping forces by Myanmar's borders;
 - d. *Expresses* its intention to great consideration, where appropriate, to how peacekeeping forces and humanitarian aid personnel to exercise their primary responsibility in the prevention and in combating human trafficking.
3. *Reiterates its call upon* the proper usage of diplomatic channels to ensure the peaceful and constructive resolution of escalating conflicts in motion across Myanmar;
4. *Strongly condemns* the violation of human rights especially the unlawful usurpation of the Tatmadaw, including those actions that involve armed conflict in situations of such as

but not limited to physical violence, attacks against civilian peoples, abduction and forced displacement, human trafficking, and denial of humanitarian aid;

5. *Calls upon* the Member States of the United Nations to further their economic sanctions and arms embargoes on the Tatmadaw;
 - a. *Implores* the Member States to freeze all financial and material assets of the Tatmadaw in all foreign nations.
 - b. *Regrets* any and all foreign military aid provided by any organization to the Tatmadaw that actively oppresses its people.
6. *Fully supports* the deployment of the *UN Peacekeepers* within the state of Myanmar to ensure the protection of the political opponents' and ethnic minorities in order to protect and promote human rights and the restoration of the rule of law in Myanmar;
7. *Remains* actively seized on this matter.
